Government Structure

The **City of Boise**, the county seat of **Ada County**, has a strong mayor-council form of government. The Mayor manages the day-to-day operations of the city, provides leadership and policy direction to the six member City Council, and chairs all meetings of the Council, voting only to break a deadlock. Both the Mayor and City Council Members are elected at-large by popular vote. Ada County is governed by a three member Board of Commissioners.

The Idaho Department of Health and Welfare is divided into seven different Public Health Regions which provide preventive health services and education to several counties. Boise falls under the purview of the Central District Health Department (CDHD) in District 4. CDHC is headed by a seven member Board of Health and provides public health services and programs to Ada, Boise, Elmore, and Valley counties.

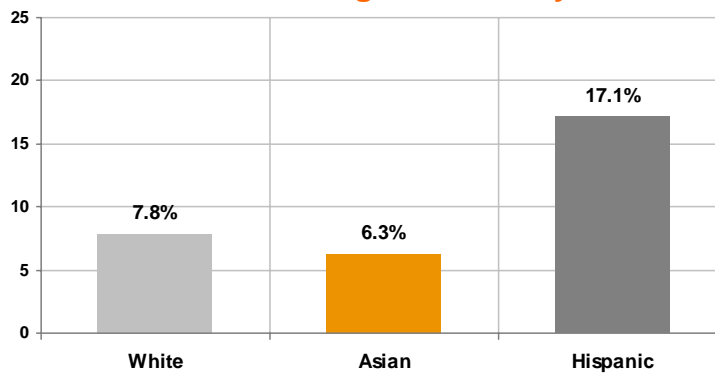

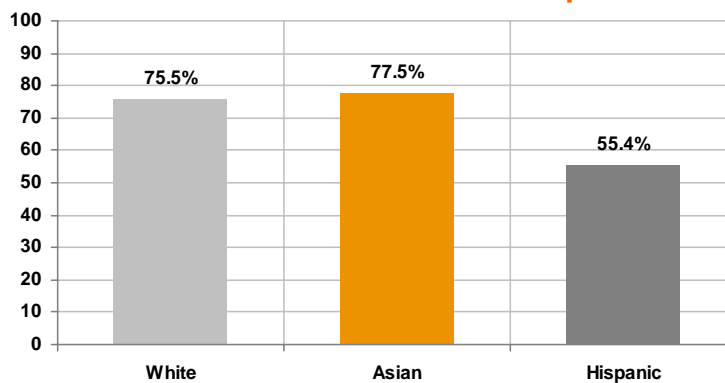

Share of Mothers That Received Adequate Prenatal Care by Race and Ethnicity



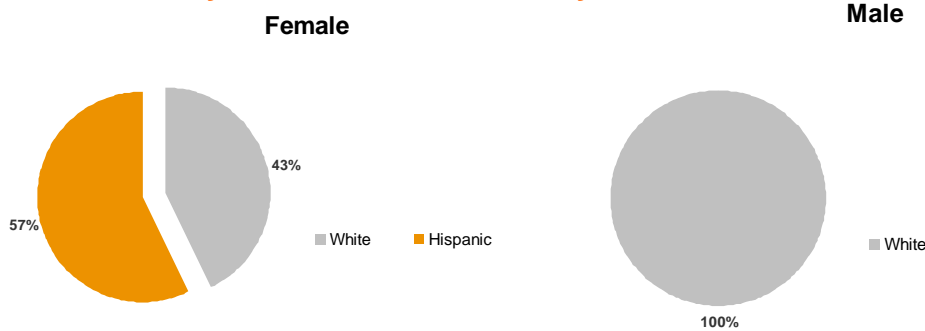

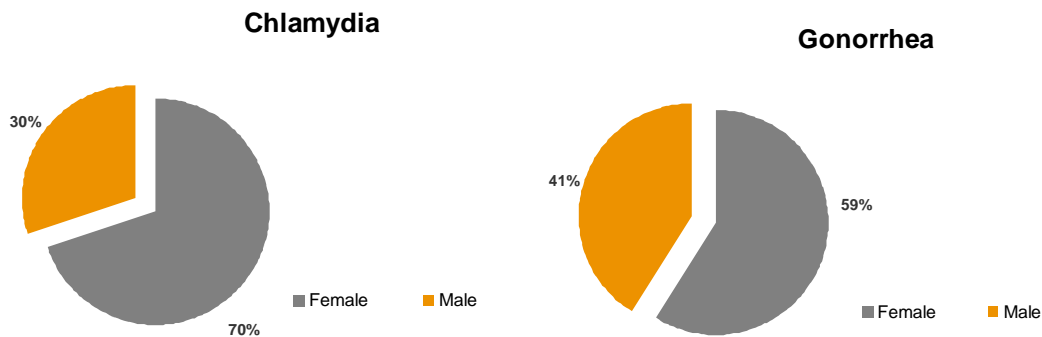
