Government Structure

The **City of Chicago**, the county seat of **Cook County**, has a mayor-council form of government. The Mayor is the chief executive while the City Council, elected from the 50 separate wards of the city, is the legislative body. The Mayor directs city departments and appoints department heads, with the advice and consent of the City Council, and has the power to veto ordinances or bills passed by the Council.

The majority of Chicago lies in Cook County, which is governed by a 17 member Board of Commissioners, each representing a district, and a Board President, elected at-large. Parts of Chicago overlap into **DuPage County**, which is governed by a County Board, comprised of 18 Board Members—three from each of the County’s six districts—and a Board President.

The Chicago Department of Public Health is responsible for the public health services for the city. The Cook County Department of Public Health is the state-certified public health agency for suburban Cook County with the exception of Chicago, Evanston, Skokie, Oak Park, and Stickney Township.

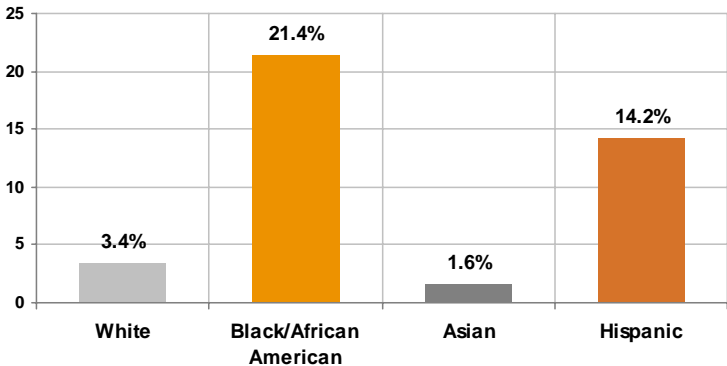

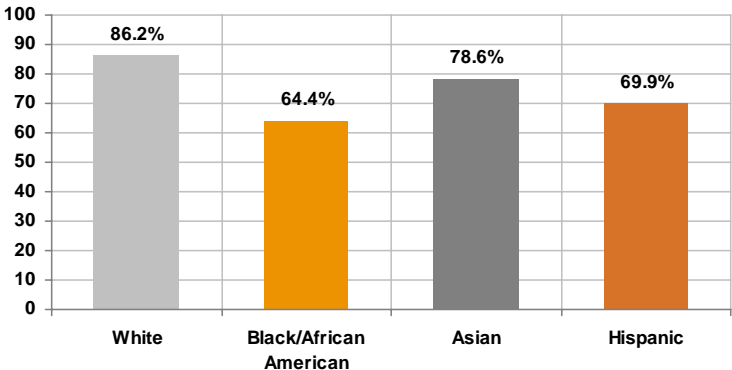

Share of Mothers That Received Adequate Prenatal Care by Race and Ethnicity



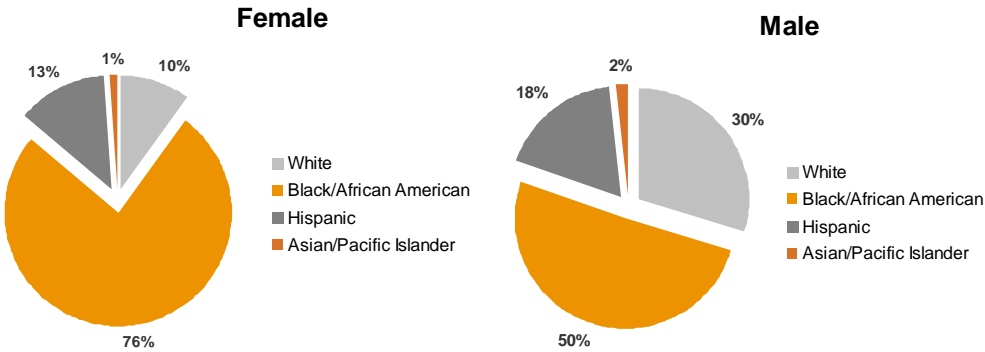
