Government Structure

The **City of Durham**, which is the county seat for **Durham County**, has a council-manager form of government. Durham is governed by a city manager and a seven member City Council. The City Council is comprised of three members who are elected through ward elections, three members who are elected at-large, and a mayor. The Council is responsible for legislating and policy making, as well as appointing the city manager, who oversees the daily functioning of the government, supervises the implementation of the Council's policies, and prepares the annual budget. Durham County is governed by a 5-member Board of County Commissioners, who are elected at-large.

The City and County of Durham have a combined Health Department, which is overseen by an 11 member Board of Health and a health director. The Board, whose members are appointed by the Durham County Board of Commissioners, makes public health policies and rules. The Durham County Health Department has seven divisions, including Administration, Community Health, Dental, Environmental Health, General Services Clinic, Health Education, and Nutrition.

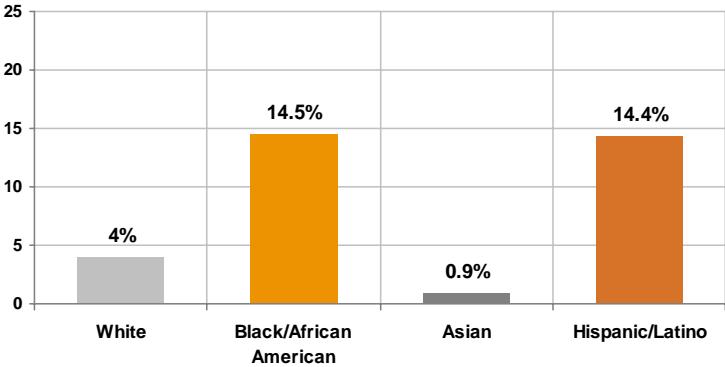

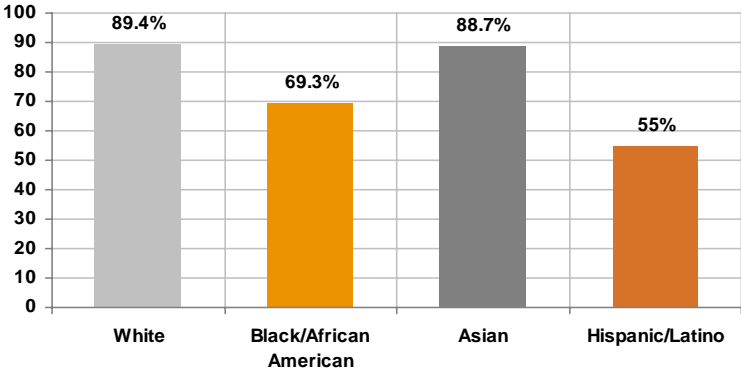

Share of Mothers That Received Adequate Prenatal Care by Race and Ethnicity

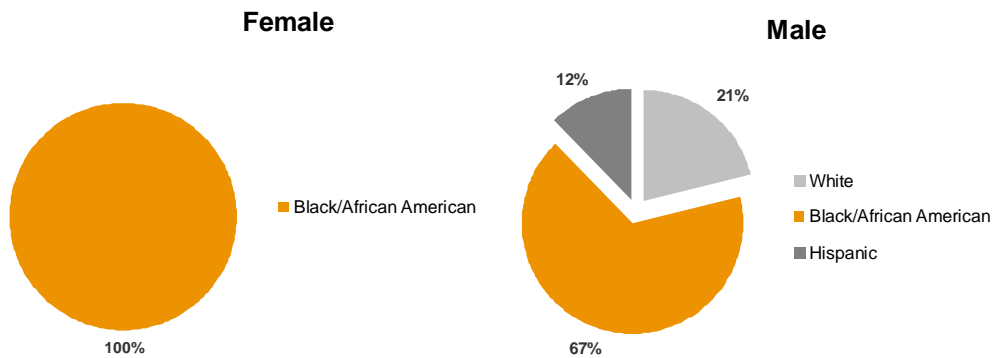

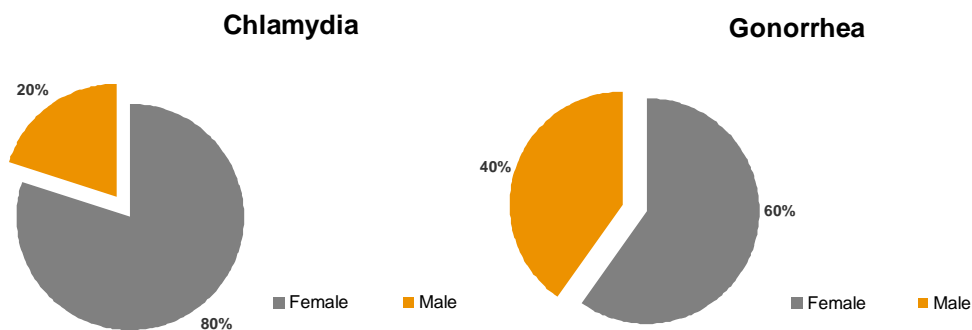
