Government Structure

Iowa City is a charter city with a council-manager form of government. The City Council consists of seven Council Members, four of whom are elected at-large and three of whom are elected from their respective districts. The Council elects a Mayor and Mayor Pro Tem from among its Members. The Mayor is a voting Member of the Council, the official representative of the city, presiding officer of the Council and its policy spokesperson. The Council appoints a City Manager who is the chief administrative officer of the city and ensures that the laws of the city are executed and enforced.

Iowa City is the county seat of **Johnson County**. The legislative body of Johnson County is the Board of Supervisors, composed of five members, elected at-large. The Board of Supervisors are responsible for appointing key personnel, approving the budget, and enacting county ordinances.

Health services for Iowa City are administered through the Johnson County Public Health Department. The five member Board of Supervisors, which is the legislative body of the county, appoints a five member Board of Health that is responsible for enforcing state health laws, adopting policy rules and regulations, and appointing a Director to head the department.

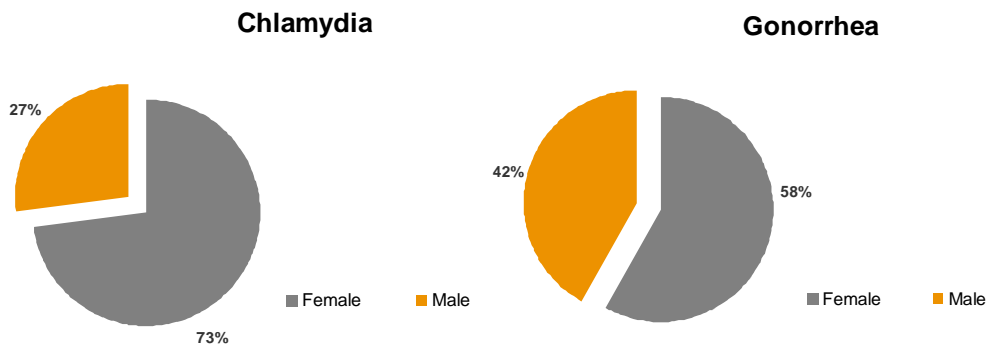
