Government Structure

Milwaukee, the county seat of **Milwaukee County**, has a strong mayor-council form of government. Legislative and policy-making power lies with the 15 member Common Council. The Council Members are elected from the city's 15 districts and the President of the Common Council is elected by the Council Members at the beginning of the term. The Mayor, elected on a city-wide ballot to a four-year term, ensures that state laws and city ordinances are observed and enforced, prepares the annual city budget, appoints department heads, and has the power to veto any Council actions.

The City of Milwaukee Health Department oversees the public health programs for the city and is divided into three divisions: Disease Control and Environmental Health, Family and Community Health, and Laboratory Services.

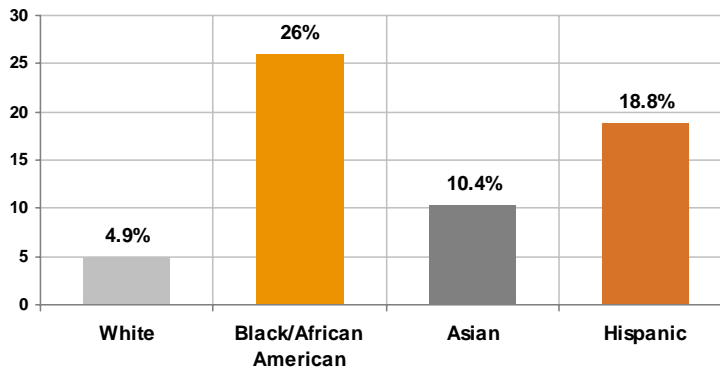

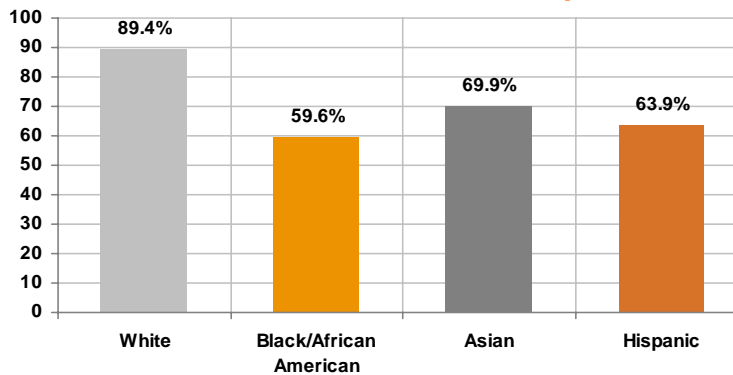

Share of Mothers That Received Adequate Prenatal Care by Race and Ethnicity



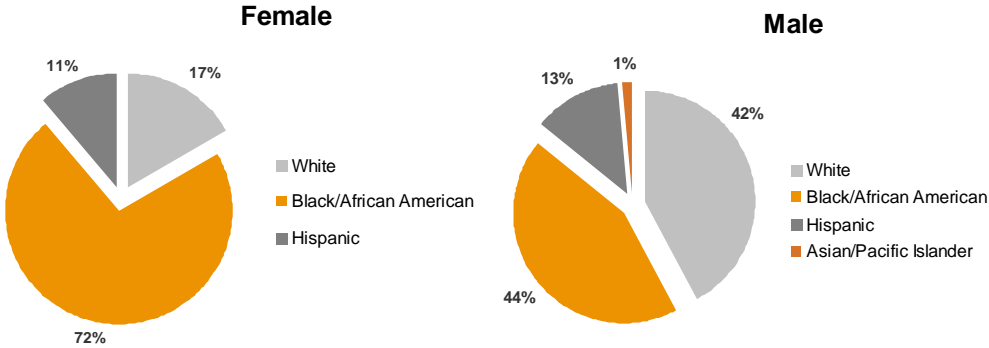
