Government Structure

Minneapolis is a charter city with a mayor-council form of government. The City Council is made up of 13 Council Members from separate wards of the city. The Council levies taxes, enacts ordinances and resolutions, licenses businesses, and exercises budgetary and policy control over city departments. The Mayor appoints some city officials and has approval or veto power over all Council actions.

The Minneapolis Department of Health and Family Support oversees public health programs for the city. In addition, a 22 member Public Health Advisory Committee (PHAC) advises the City Council and the Department of Health and Family Support on policy matters affecting the health of Minneapolis residents and serves as liaison between the city and the community in addressing health concerns.

Minneapolis is the county seat of **Hennepin County**. The Hennepin County Human Services and Public Health Department is divided into seven areas: Children, Youth, & Family; Prevention and Health Promotion; Emergencies; Environmental Health; Family Planning and Sexual Health; Low-Cost Health Care, and Data Reports; and Records.

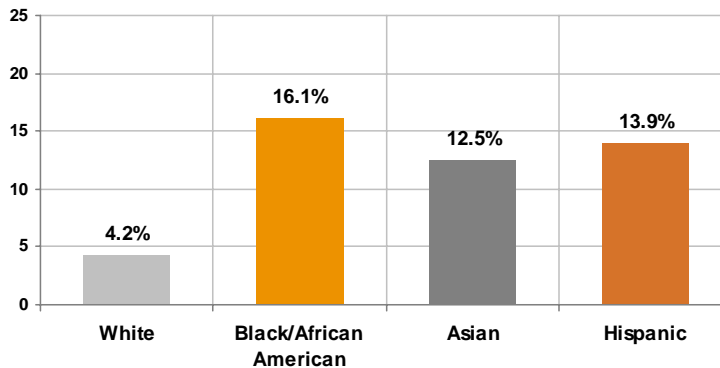

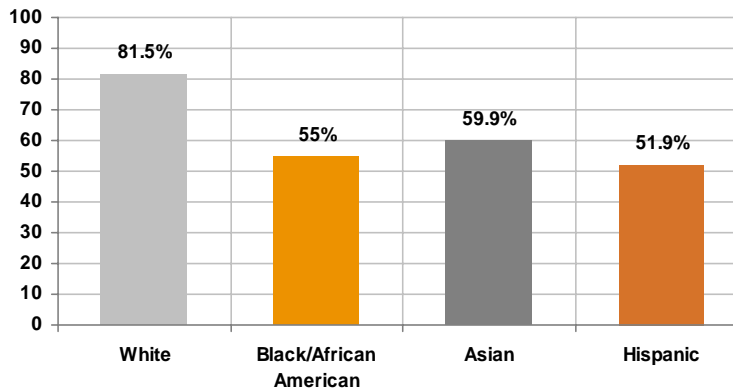

Share of Mothers That Received Adequate Prenatal Care by Race and Ethnicity



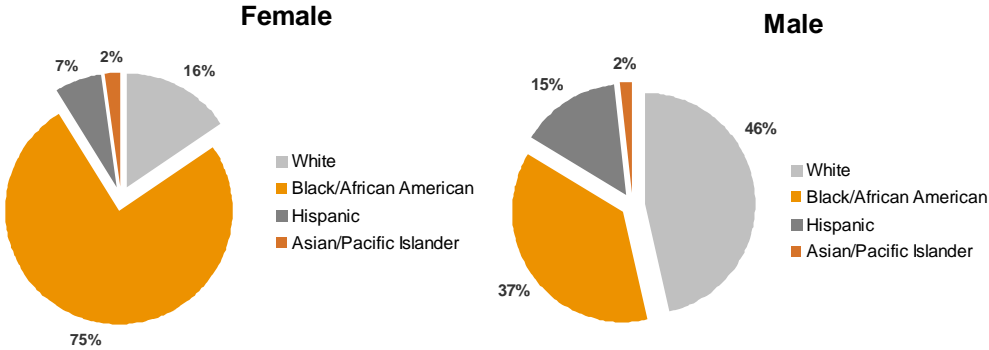
