Government Structure

The **City of Oakland** has a mayor-council form of government. The City Council, which serves as Oakland's governing body, creates legislation and ordinances. The Council consists of seven members who are nominated by their respective districts and one member who is elected at-large. The Mayor, who is elected at-large, advises the Council, appoints and directs the City Administrator, and promotes commerce and economic development.

Alameda County is governed by a Board of Supervisors whose five members are directly elected by voters in the county's five districts. The Board is in charge of setting policy and supervising county operations. Citizens are encouraged to apply for positions on Alameda Boards and Commissions, which advise the Board of Supervisors.

The Alameda County Public Health Department, which operates under the supervision of a Director/Health Officer, has five major divisions: Administrative Services; Community Health Services; Communicable Diseases Control and Prevention; Emergency Medical Services; and Planning, Assessment and Health Equity. The Department provides a range of health services including assessments, disease prevention and control, community outreach, policy development, education, and medical care.

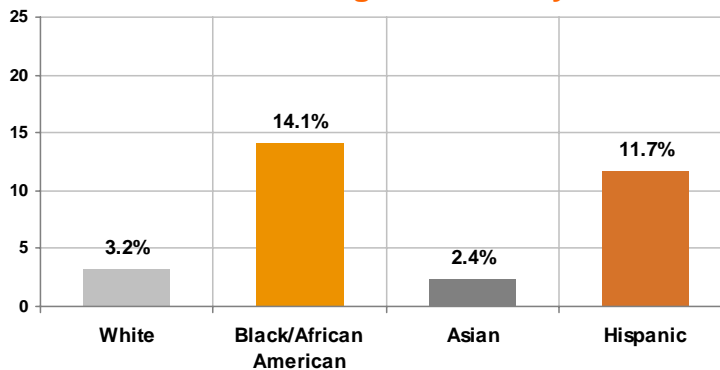

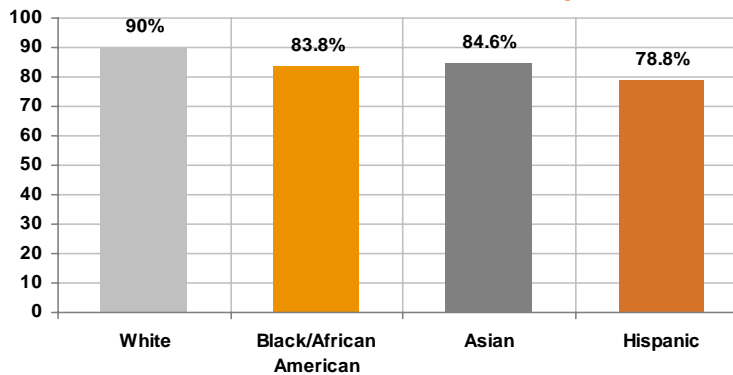

Share of Mothers That Received Adequate Prenatal Care by Race and Ethnicity



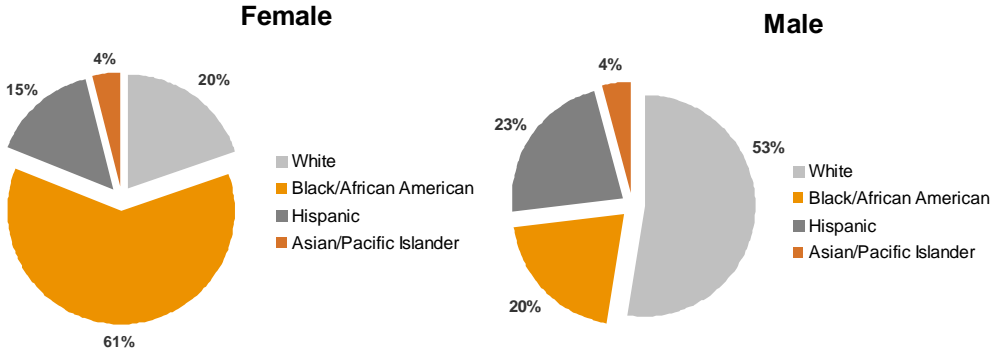

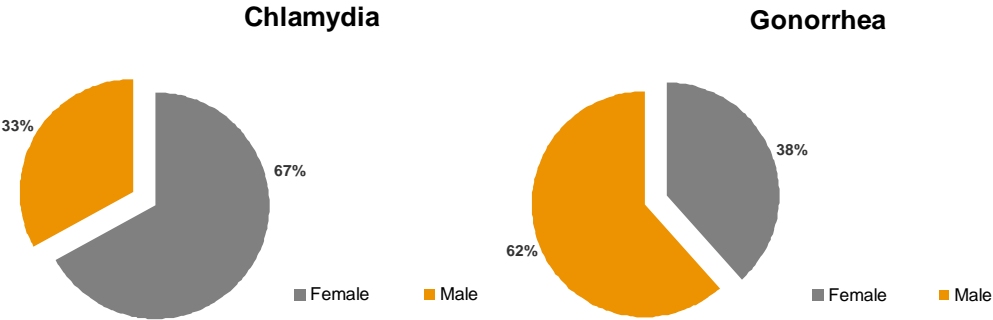
